## COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PY2019 ACTION PLAN

The City of Kent will hold the second of two required public hearings on Wednesday, November 4, 2020 at 6:55 p.m. for a proposed Substantial Amendment to the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) PY2019 Annual Action Plan, as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), for the allocation of Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) Round 3 funding awarded to the City of Kent under the authority of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (CARES Act). The hearing provides the City with the opportunity to present the public with information regarding the special allocation of 162,666.00 in CDBG-CV Round 3 funds, including information on HUD's guidance regarding the overall objectives of the CARES Act and CDBG-CV funding and the types of eligible activities that may be funded with the additional allocation. The public hearing will have time allotted for comments and questions from the public regarding proposed objectives and activities the City should consider regarding programming and uses for the CDBG-CV funding.

The <u>Public Hearing</u> will be held virtually online on <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>November 4, 2020 at 6:55 p.m.</u> and will be broadcast live on the City of Kent's YouTube Channel.
