Kent City Health Department to Offer COVID-19 Booster Shots to Eligible Individuals

KENT, OH – The Kent City Health Department will begin offering COVID-19 booster shots starting Monday, November 15, 2021 to eligible individuals. Customers must schedule ahead of time via the health department’s website through SignUp Genius or by calling into the department.

To ensure doses are not wasted, certain vaccines will only be available on certain days.

- Monday – Moderna boosters or first/second doses
- Wednesday – Johnson & Johnson boosters or full doses
- Friday – Pfizer boosters or first/second doses

At this time, only certain populations are eligible for COVID-19 booster shots.

- Individuals over the age of 65,
- Over the age of 18 and living in a long-term care facility,
- Over the age of 18 with underlying medical conditions, or
- Over the age of 18 and working in a high-risk setting.

Booster shots are only available six (6) months after completing the primary COVID-19 immunization series or for anyone two (2) months after a Johnson & Johnson vaccine. For more information on eligibility, please visit:
