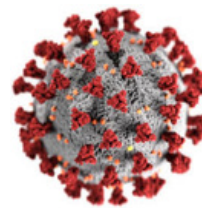




Stop the Spread of COVID-19



The Kent City Health Department will soon be conducting housing inspections at this property. Please take precautions to limit the potential spread of COVID-19. Taking the following actions will allow the inspection to go more quickly, safely, and thoroughly.

Prepare the unit for inspection:

- Smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms should be installed with working batteries
- Hallways, doorways, and other means of egress should be unobstructed
- Fire extinguishers should be clearly visible
- Address property maintenance issues and work orders before the inspection

Tenants are encouraged to leave the property during the inspection:

- Animals should be caged or removed from the property during inspection
- Turning on lights and bathroom fans is recommended
- If the tenant needs to communicate with the inspector, a note can be left at the door explaining potential issues

During the inspection:

- Cloth masks should be worn by tenants, property owners, and inspectors
- Social distancing should be practiced by tenants, property owners, and inspectors



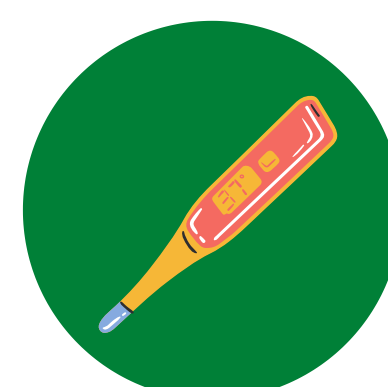
Clean and disinfect "high-touch" surfaces



Wear a face covering when you go out



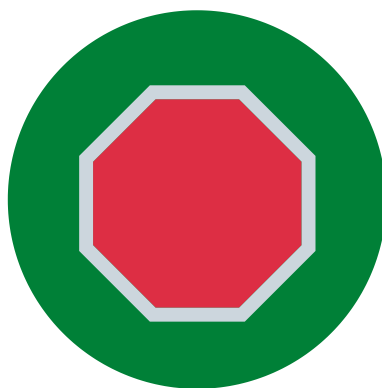
Stay home except for work and other essential needs
